



Community Choice Pantry Documents Needed

- **Food Pantry Service:** Food is available **once every 30 days**, and recertification is required once per year.
- **The Pantry is open Monday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday: 9-10:45am and 1-2:45pm**
- Please refer to our website for information on holidays and other necessary closures.

You must print all documents prior to arriving. We cannot accept emails or documents on your phone.

When you register for the first time, please try to come as close to our opening time as possible and expect to be here for an extended period of time to allow time to review documents.

Who Must Come?

- The Head of Household and all adults (18+) who want pantry services must come in person to register.
- All adults must provide the same documents.

Photo ID Required

Bring a current photo ID. We also accept:

- MVA replacement ID paperwork
- Jail release ID
- Hospital ID
- School ID
- Valid passport
- Consular ID
- CASA de Maryland ID

Proof of Address

You must live in **Baltimore County** and provide one document showing your name and address. The Head of Household must be listed on the lease or home title.

Accepted documents:

- Home deed/mortgage statement
- Current lease
- Current BGE bill
- Current Xfinity bill
- Current state/federal-issued documents (Social Services, Medicaid, SNAP, Child Support, Probation, or Court papers)
- Voter ID
- Car registration



Proof of Income

All adults must provide proof of income:

- Pay stubs from the last 30 days
- SSI, SSDI, TCA, Section 8
- Child support
- Unemployment
- Pension

If you have no income, complete the No Income Verification section of the intake form. If you receive SNAP, TANF, Section 8 or any other non-cash benefits, bring your award letter.

Children Under 18

For each child, provide one of the following:

- Birth certificate showing you are the parent (Verification of Birth or Affidavit of Parentage accepted for the first 3 months after birth)
- School registration form showing you as parent or guardian
- Current court showing custody or guardianship or Social Services formal kinship care document showing custody or guardianship

Power of Attorney

Provide a Power of Attorney document for any adult (18+) if applicable.
